Professional Experience

Ms. Adrienne Tober is a Project Professional at SCS Tracer Environmental, Carlsbad, California office. The main focus of her work is the completion and updating of Process Safety Management Programs (PSM) / Risk Management Programs (RMP) / California Accidental Release Prevention Programs (CalARP) projects for regulated facilities using hazardous materials. Ms. Tober also prepares hazardous materials business plans, develops and updates piping and instrumentation diagrams, conducts Standard Operating Procedure Annual Reviews, conducts Compliance Audits, scribes for Hazard Reviews, and completes the modeling of the potential off-site consequences of the release of a hazardous chemical. In addition, she assists clients with their response to regulatory agency comments and requests for information.

Ms. Tober also assists California clients by tracking their regulatory compliance deadlines. The PSM, RMP, and CalARP regulations require the completion of recurring tasks such as compliance audits every three years and revalidations every five years. Ms. Tober tracks these dates and generates client proposals as reminders. She is also responsible for maintaining the risk group's active project backlog. Ms. Tober is currently part-time.

The majority of Ms. Tober's experience in risk management includes ammonia refrigeration facilities and municipal water districts. Clients include nationwide cold storage and distribution companies, local food processing facilities, and water treatment and water reclamation plants.

Prior to joining SCS Tracer in 2000, Ms. Tober was employed by an environmental/civil engineering firm, as an Engineering Assistant. She was responsible for compiling and analyzing sedimentation and flow data and assisting other engineers with the calibration of flow models. She also prepared floodplain maps using ArcView. Ms. Tober earned an associate degree in Business Administration before attending the University of California at San Diego, where she received a B.S. in Chemical Engineering.

Specific project involvement includes the following:
